

**CHAPTER 2.00 - SCHOOL BOARD GOVERNANCE AND ORGANIZATION**

**MEMBERSHIP OF THE SCHOOL BOARD**

**2.101**

The School Board of Franklin County shall consist of five (5) members, each of whom shall be nominated and elected only by the qualified electors who reside in the same residence area as the member. Each member is elected for a term of four (4) years and shall maintain said residency throughout the duration of his/her term of office. "Said residency" means the School Board member residence area from which he/she was elected. Three (3) members shall be elected at the time of the presidential election and two (2) members shall be elected at the time of the gubernatorial election.

- (1) The office of any School Board member shall be vacant when the member moves his/her residence from the School Board member residence area from which he/she was elected.
- (2) School Board members may be removed from office under the provisions of Article IV, Section 7, Florida Constitution. Any vacancy on the School Board shall be filled by the Governor's appointment.
