

CHAPTER 4.00 – Curriculum and Instruction

PHYSICAL EDUCATION/ORGANIZED PROGRAM

4.101

The Franklin County School Board shall offer a physical education/organized program that stresses physical fitness and encourages healthy, active lifestyles. All students in PreK-5, unless under doctor's orders to abstain, shall participate in the school's physical education/organized program. The program will consist of age-appropriate physical activities of at least moderate intensity level and for duration sufficient to provide a significant health benefit to students. All students in grades K-5 will engage in a minimum of three (3) physical education/organized program classes per week.

The physical education/organized program will include, but not be limited to the following:

- Exercises that promote cardiovascular fitness and flexibility;
- Activities which will contribute to the student's motor, cognitive, and affective abilities; and
- Provide a continuum of services designed to meet the needs of students with disabilities as determined through the Individual Educational Plan (IEP).
