READMISSION OF STUDENTS

5.14

- (1) Students who have previously withdrawn from school may be readmitted under the following conditions:
 - (A) A student who is sixteen (16) years or older and who has been withdrawn previously, regardless of the reason, may apply to the next school principal to reenter at the beginning of the next semester.
 - (B) A student who is sixteen (16) years or older and who has withdrawn twice for non-attendance during a school year shall be permitted to reenroll at the school principal's discretion at the beginning of the next school year.
 - (C) A student who has previously withdrawn from a District school and who is over the age of twenty (20) shall be enrolled into an adult education program to enable him/her to pursue a high school diploma.
 - (D) A high school principal shall consider a student's previous academic and disciplinary record, post high school plans, and curriculum needs when agreeing to reenter a student who is eighteen (18) years or older and who has been withdrawn previously.
- (2) Students who have been expelled from school may apply to the School Board for readmission. It is the student's responsibility to make application for readmission.
