

CHAPTER 5.00 - STUDENTS

SCHOLARSHIPS

5.90+

- I. Information about scholarships shall be made available, and students shall be encouraged to apply for scholarships for postsecondary studies.
- II. The principal shall respond to any written request for information such as grade point average, rank in class, conduct and school activities provided that the student has initiated the request and the parent, as defined by Florida Statutes, has authorized the release of such information.
- III. A college or university, military service, agency or organization may request in advance that a scholarship be awarded at regularly scheduled awards ceremony. The sponsor of the scholarship must be a recognized school or organization whose standards and purposes are consistent with the mission and goals of the Franklin County School District.
- IV. The Superintendent shall develop procedures for the presentation of scholarships at school and/or District ceremonies.
