

Open for Bid: One 8' x 12' garden shed constructed by the Carpentry Class at Franklin County School. The shed is constructed with winged gables at both ends and architectural details cut into the rafter tails to add a little flair. Double doors that open out for a 5' opening contribute to the utility of the building. Two high awning windows allow light without compromising security. Cement fiberboard (Hardie) was used for the siding, #1 KD pressure-treated pine for the trim, and stainless steel fasteners were used for all exterior applications, adding to the overall appearance and low maintenance. The interior is unfinished to allow maximum flexibility for the ultimate owner. Purchaser will be responsible for relocation of shed. Bids start at \$2500 with 100% of proceeds going directly to the Carpentry classes at FCS to be used for material purchases.
