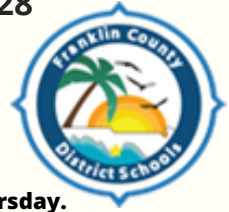

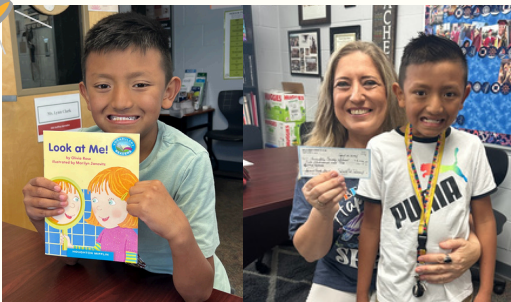

Caleb A. Ramirez is from Mexico and lost his hearing as an infant. He learned Mexican Sign Language and communicated a little bit with his parents that way. Since coming to the United States he has learned American Sign Language and is learning to read. Thank you, Linda McQuagge for working with him last spring. Lynn Lamont says he is eligible for speech therapy, but without hearing aids it will not be as productive. Caleb makes friends quickly and does well in his 1st-grade classroom with his 1:1 aide, Makayla Stansberry.

Lynn Clark, ESE specialist, shares an update as the chair of the fundraiser, "to date, we have collected \$6,058 from our community, including a donation of \$2,000 from Mid Florida Corvette Club from Central Florida. He has doctor appointments on schedule for a hearing aid fitting. The total cost of the Play PX 2-T hearing aid is \$2080. The additional funds collected will allow us to support him with any follow-up needs for the next couple of years as he grows."
