JULY 13, 2020: DISTRICT RESPONSE TO POSITIVE COVID-19 CASES

The Franklin County School District was made aware of two employees testing positive for COVID-19. Both employees were asymptomatic and took immediate steps to mitigate the spread after receiving test results. All employees having direct contact with those who tested positive have been required to voluntarily self-quarantine for a period of 14 days. All work areas will be thoroughly cleaned on a continual basis to sanitize our facilities. All employees have been informed of CDC guidelines and recommendations for precautionary measures to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. If employees cannot maintain social distancing guidelines, masks are strongly encouraged.

Prior to the pandemic, the district began taking safety and security measures that will further mitigate the spread, such as bullet proofing the front office area, single points of entry, minimizing non-essential visitors on campus.

Superintendent Yoder has worked in conjunction with our local Health Department leaders and the district is following all of the Health Department's recommended protocols. Our campuses remain open for business, limiting non-essential services and visitors on our campuses. Please be aware that safety protocols are in place to ensure the safety of our team and our visitors.

Our district leadership team will continue to work with our local and state agencies to plan and prepare to safely welcome our students and staff back on campus.
