Scholarship Information & Application

Introduction

This scholarship program is intended to provide a Franklin County Student with a scholarship to assist in his/her post-secondary undergraduate study. A five hundred dollar (\$500.00) scholarship will be awarded to a deserving graduate each year. The scholarship award is to be used for tuition, books, supplies or any expense involved in pursuing a post-secondary education.

The recipient will be chosen by a committee which shall be appointed by the Sheriff. The committee will consist of five (5) Sheriff's Office employees who do not have a relationship with any potential recipient.

Nominees will be ranked by the following:

- Grade-Point Average
- Civic & School Activities
- Leadership Acknowledgements
- Letters of Recommendation
- Scholarship Application Essay

Application Packet Must Include

1. This completed application.
2. Proof of future graduation from Franklin County School.
3. Acceptance letter from an accredited college, university, or vocation training institute.
4. Transcript with seventh semester cumulative grade point average, un-weighted, of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
5. Proof of membership of school/civic clubs or sports.
6. Two letters of recommendation that relate to the students scholastic success, leadership qualities, civic and school activities.
7. One page essay about what your ideal future looks like.

Application Process

1. Completed scholarship application must be submitted no later than May 9, 2023, to the Franklin County Sheriff's Office.

3. You will be contacted whether you were accepted or denied the scholarship.

Award Details

The scholarship award shall be honored in the following manner:

- (a) A scholarship selection committee composed of Sheriff's Office employees shall be established to review each application and the supporting documentation received. Scholarship determination is within the discretion of the Franklin County Sheriff's Office. All decisions are final.

- (b) The scholarship will be awarded to the recipient during the Franklin County School awards ceremony. The recipient will receive a certificate and a letter from the Franklin County Sheriff's Office.
- (c) The recipient must submit proof of first semester class enrollment within six (6) months from graduation date to receive the scholarship funds.
- (d) The award must be used for tuition, books or any expense related to attendance at a post-secondary institution.

Forfeiture

The recipient shall forfeit the scholarship if he or she fails to show proof of class enrollment at the approved, accredited post-secondary institution. This proof must be submitted within six (6) months from the date of graduation.
