

Wynn Family Scholarship

The Wynn Family will offer a scholarship to a high school senior who desires to pursue postsecondary, trade or vocational education. The purpose of the scholarship is to help alleviate some of the financial burden of tuition. Students must be residents of Franklin County, Florida in order to be considered for the Wynn Family Scholarship.

The \$500 award, renewable for one year, may be used for trade or vocational schools, community colleges or four-year universities. After the first year of studies, students must provide grades, and proof of community service related to their field of study.

All applicants must be high school seniors attending Franklin County High School, in Eastpoint, Florida.

The applicant will be required to demonstrate why he/she is deserving of the award, based on financial need.

Essays

General prompt that must be answered by all applicants.

Based on financial need, why should you be selected as the scholarship recipient? (The essay must be well-developed. No word length is required.)

Write a 300-word essay based on one of the given prompts below. The essay will be graded on proper grammar and sentence structure.

1. Tell us about a verifiable contribution you have made to a community in Franklin County.
2. Tell us about a time when you stepped up as a leader to make a difference.
3. Describe the solutions you would propose to resolve current issues such as discrimination, a societal issue (you decide), or community problem (you decide).
4. Tell us about a book you have read and what inspired you. Why?

The deadline to apply is April 30th. Late applications will not be considered.
