### Reports:

Student – Beyla introduced herself as a student representative for FCS.

Principal ~ C. Johnson:

- a. Both schools just went through the first round of testing with 4-10th grade FSA writing.
- b. Career technical education and opportunities are being pursued for middle and high school students.
- c. Student registration is now open for all students in Franklin county to get an idea of enrollment for next year.
- d. IXL is being utilized effectively and with validity.
- e. DE will not be used as an assessment piece next year. IReady; NWEA map and another option are being explored to replace DE.

### Open Agenda:

- a. Ms. Burt expressed a great concern about FOCUS. It often provides incorrect information regarding GPAs/Credit awareness and etc. She emphasized how critical is it for the information on FOCUS to be correct for students and parents. It was suggested to have a parent workshop on how to use FOCUS, but only if the information provided on FOCUS is corrected.
- b. Schedules will be out by Spring.
- c. Mr. O’Grady was asked about DATE for testing to begin on school improvement plan. He reported most of the information can be found online.
- d. Ms. Sizemore gave a quick report:
  - i. Dual Enrollment will be coming out soon.
  - ii. 6-8th grade girls from ABC and FCS had a great time on the “Girl’s Night Out” trip to GCSC. This trip focused on STEM activities.
  - iii. She is now looking into a “Boy’s Night Out”.
  - iv. She is also working on a college/higher education trip each year from 9-12th grade for our students.(Jr College, University, Lively, and etc.)
